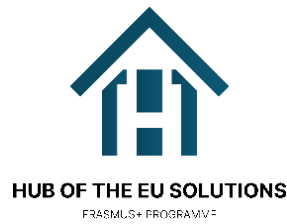

As a result of the panel discussion, a collection of abstracts will be published in electronic format and will be available on the website of the National University of "Ostroh Academy". Applications for

participation in the panel discussion and abstracts are accepted until June 15, 2024, inclusive, at the following email address: marta.khrin@oa.edu.ua (application form attached).

Participation of higher education students is possible together with a scientific supervisor and/or with a review from a scientific supervisor.

Requirements for the formatting of abstracts:

- Length: up to 5 pages in MS Word, Times New Roman font, size 14 pt, single spacing, paragraph indent: 1.25 cm; margins: top - 3 cm; left, right, and bottom - 2 cm.
- Figures should be placed in the text, text wrapping - top and bottom, alignment - center. Under the figure, specify the numbering (Fig. 1.) and title, aligned to the center.
- Tables should be numbered (Table 1.) and titled, aligned to the center. The font size in tables - 14 or 12, spacing - 1.
- Applications and abstracts should be submitted as separate files named as follows: Petrenko_Application (for the application), Petrenko_Abstract (for the abstract) in doc. or docx. format.

ATTENTION! The authors are responsible for the accuracy and uniqueness of the material submitted for publication. Abstracts should be carefully prepared according to the requirements. The organizing committee reserves the right to reject abstracts that do not meet the established requirements.

Structure of the abstract:

- Title of the abstract (bold, size: 14, center-aligned).
- Author's full name (bold, size: 14, left-aligned, no more than 3 authors allowed) and information (academic degree, academic title (if any), position, educational institution, place of work if graduated; city where it is located, country. Higher education student should also indicate the level of higher education (first, second, third) and information about the scientific supervisor (regular font, size: 14).
- Main text.
- List of references (in alphabetical order or in the order of citation). References should be formatted according to the National Standard of Ukraine DSTU 8302:2015. Citations in the text should be in square brackets indicating page numbers of the relevant source, for example: [3, p. 28].
