Memorandum of Understanding

between

The University of St Andrews,¹ Scotland

and

The National University of Ostroh Academy

In signing this Memorandum of Understanding, the University of St Andrews (St Andrews) and the National University of Ostroh Academy (NUOA) acknowledge their desire to establish and develop cooperative links between their institutions, in order to facilitate academic development through the sharing of ideas and teaching practices, and to promote sustainable academic activity and international education.

Status of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

- 1.1 This document is not intended to be legally binding.
- 1.2 This document may be the basis for the preparation of formal contracts or agreements between the parties.
- 1.3 The parties do not intend to enter into any legal relationship unless and until such formal contracts or agreements are executed.

Objectives of the parties

- 2.1 St Andrews and NUOA desire to work together to expand co-operation and the exchange of ideas in areas of mutual interest.
- 2.2 Both institutions wish to undertake programmes and activities in co-operation with each other and specifically with Institute of Socio-Humanitarian Management, Institute of International Relations and National Security, I. Malynovskyi Institute of Law, Faculty of Romance and Germanic Languages, Faculty of Economics (from NUOA) in the first phase.
- 2.3 Both institutions shall consider undertaking collaborative projects in the areas of:

a. research and consultancy;

- b. joint teaching programmes;
- c. exchange of teaching staff, researchers and/or students;
- d. training courses, seminars, workshops and conferences;
- e. joint PhD programmes;
- f. such other activities as the parties shall agree.

Co-ordination and Management

- 3. To fulfil the aims of this MoU the institutions shall appoint a co-ordinator to develop and manage the joint activities undertaken, specific details of which shall be set out in formal agreements. Any such formal agreements shall include:
 - a. the responsibilities of each institution;
 - b. a schedule of the specific activity;
 - c. a budget and sources of finance for each activity;
 - d. management details for the conduct of each activity.

Duration and Termination

- 4.1 This MoU shall take effect on the date of the last signature by the institutions' legal representatives and shall remain in force for a period of five years. The MoU may be extended by mutual agreement.
- 4.2 This MoU may be amended by mutual consent of the parties. Amendments shall become part of this MoU when approved in writing by both parties.
- 4.3 Any disagreement concerning the interpretation or execution of this MoU shall be resolved through direct negotiations between both parties.
- 4.4 Either party may at any time terminate the MoU by sending the other party written notice of intent to terminate. Notice of intent to terminate shall not affect projects or programmes already in operation.
